An order transferring the town of Francestown from New Hampshire
Planning Region 4 to New Hampshire Planning Region 5b

WHEREAS, RSA 36:45 provides that the boundaries of the delineated planning regions in the State may be adjusted to accommodate changing conditions;

WHEREAS, the Selectmen of the Town of Francestown filed a request with the Director of the Office of Energy and Planning, to transfer the Town from New Hampshire Planning Region 4 to New Hampshire Planning Region 5b;


WHEREAS, the Francestown Board of Selectmen solicited comments from the Planning Board and Conservation Commission and unanimously agreed that Francestown should request a change to Region 5b;

WHEREAS, Region 4, Southwest Region Planning Commission, and Region 5b, Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission, concur in this transfer request by the Town of Francestown;
and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Energy and Planning approved the transfer;

NOW, THEREFORE, I MARGARET WOOD HASSAN, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, by the authority vested in me under Part II, Article 41 of the New Hampshire Constitution, do hereby order that the Town of Francestown is transferred from New Hampshire Planning Region 4 to New Hampshire Planning Region 5b, effective upon signature.
