A Proclamation

VETERANS DAY
NOVEMBER 11, 2015

WHEREAS, We pay special tribute to the members of New Hampshire's National Guard, who respond with courage when called upon to provide service both at home and abroad; and

WHEREAS, We also recognize the families of our veterans, who also make tremendous sacrifices; and

WHEREAS, New Hampshire's Veterans Cemetery, New Hampshire State Office of Veterans Services, the New Hampshire Veterans Home, the United States Department of Veterans Affairs and Medical Center, and all of our veterans organizations should be commended for the support and services they provide;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARGARET WOOD HASSAN, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby proclaim **NOVEMBER 11, 2015**, as **VETERANS DAY** in the State of New Hampshire and ask all residents to participate in the many activities planned for observing this day. I further call upon all residents and businesses to mark this day with proud display of the flag of the United States as a reaffirmation of our national unity.
